



BCNM COVID – 19 Safety Guidelines For Inlow and Sivells 2021

We are excited to open our camps to guests this summer! In order to protect your families and our staff we ask that you please observe the following COVID-19 Safety Guidelines while traveling to and residing on campus:

- Take each person's temperature before loading up to leave. Anyone with a fever of 100 degrees or higher should stay home.
- Take the temperature of each member of your church group each morning. (Please note: you will need to provide your own thermometer)
 - Anyone with a fever of **100 degrees** or higher will be isolated in a safe place until his or her parents can come to retrieve them.
 - If someone is not feverish but feeling sick otherwise, they will be isolated in a safe place until his or her parent can come to retrieve them.
- All guests will be required to wear masks when in public areas of the campus (for example, entering and moving about the dining hall).
- Masks will be worn in all large group gatherings including but not limited to worship, Bible study and small groups that are larger than 8 people – who are not from your church group.
- As long as three feet of physical distance is utilized for outdoor rec, masks will not be required.
- To the greatest extent possible, please maintain a physical distance of three feet:
 - when standing in line for the dining hall
 - when in small groups of larger than 8 who are not from your same church group
 - when participating in other activities.
- Wash your hands frequently and use the hand sanitizer stations that will be set up throughout the campus.
